This Project consists of full roof replacement at main roof and bulkhead roofs, removal and reinstallation of terra cotta copings with new stainless steel flashing at the main roof, replacement of copings with new cast stone copings with new stainless steel flashing at bulkheads, replacement of face brick at the top 22 courses of the bulkhead over parged backup, spray applied waterproof membrane and narrow cavity drainage plane. 2 flood lights and associated conduit must be removed and reinstalled as necessary to perform coping removal and reinstallation, with new electrical wiring and connections to the existing.
